# **Divisions & Grading**

#### Under 8

- Teams have been randomly allocated to four pools
- Grading will take place after week five (5) & again after week ten (10)

#### Under 10

- Teams have been separated into a club pool and three school pools (schools have been randomly allocated into the three pools)
- Teams in school-based pools will be regraded after Round 5

- Teams have been separated into a club pool and three school pools (schools have been randomly allocated into the three pools)

# Open Girls

- There are a total of four teams entered in the Open Girls competition
- Finals format to be announced closer to finals

#### ➤ Under 14

- Teams have been separated into club and school-based pools
- Finals format to be announced closer to finals

#### ➤ Under 16

- There are a total of 6 teams entered in the Under 16 competition
- Finals format to be announced closer to finals

# **Rules & Regulations**

The full version of the SJSA Rules & Regulations is available on the SJSA website; it is the responsibility of all individuals to be familiar with them. We want to bring the following to your attention:

#### Mini Roos:

- Kinderoos (Under 5), Under 6, Under 7, Under 7 Girls, Under 8 & Under 9 Girls
- Based on Football Victoria Mini Roos Rules
- We have made modifications to match times

#### Mini Roos - Under 10:

- · Penalties are as per FIFA rules
- Throw-ins are as per FIFA rules
- · Corner Kicks are as per FIFA rules
- Disposal of ball by the Goal-keeper
  - Ball must be played from the ground (kicked) within 6 seconds
  - Ball can be thrown or rolled from the hands
  - Goal-keeper is not permitted to kick or drop kick the ball from their hands

#### Under 12 & Under 12 Girls:

- Under 12 9 v 9 Format
- Football Victoria Competition Guidelines
- Goal size: 5 x 2m (same as U10)
- Off-side rule is played as per FIFA rules
- · Penalties are as per FIFA rules
- Throw-ins are as per FIFA rules
- · Corner Kicks are as per FIFA rules
- · Disposal of ball by the Goal-keeper
  - Ball must be played from the ground (kicked) within 6 seconds
  - · Ball can be thrown or rolled from the hands
  - Goal-keeper is not permitted to kick or drop kick the ball from their hands
- Red Card Rule for Under 12
  - Players who are shown a red card for an offence will be sent from the field
  - Players sent from the field can be replaced

#### Open Girls:

- FIFA Rules

  - Players who are shown a red card for an offence will be sent from the field
  - Players sent from the field cannot be replaced

# Under 14's

- FIFA Rules
- Red Card Rule
  - Players who are shown a red card for an offence will be sent from the field
  - Players sent from the field cannot be replaced

#### > Under 16's:

- FIFA Rules
- Red Card Rule
  - Players who are shown a red card for an offence will be sent from the field
  - Players sent from the field cannot be replaced
- Coaches & players are responsible for being familiar with the Laws of the Game (LOTG)
- LOTG are available on the FFA website (a link can be found on the SJSA website

#### Match Records & Score Sheets

- Mini Roos
  - For the 2024 Season, Match Records must be completed and handed to the Game Leader for the first four rounds only for all Mini Roo Age Groups for registration requirements.
  - No scores are to be recorded or published for any Mini Roos match
  - This includes school / club newsletters, websites & face book pages & other social media
- Under 12 & above Age Groups
  - The match record will be completed & submitted by the Referee following the match
  - It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to ensure that all details have been completes before handing it to the Referee at the end of the match

# Social Media Policy

- By signing SJSA Registration Form, all players & parents agree to adhere to the Social Media Policy
- This applies to all forms of social media

#### > Team Marshall

- Every team must have a Marshall (not the coach or team manager)
  - The Marshall must wear a fluorescent jacket to be easily visible
  - The Marshall is responsible for the behavior of all spectators affiliated with their team
  - Marshals are not permitted to be in the technical area or inside the fence at Main Pitch 2
  - Team Marshalls are to remain with the spectators & encourage positive sportsmanship throughout the duration of the match
  - Marshall must 18 years of age or older

#### > Technical Area

- Under 12 & above Age Groups
  - Only the Coach, Assistant Coach, Team Manager & players are permitted to be in the technical area
  - Parents & spectators should be on the opposite side of the field from the technical area, The exception is Main Pitch 2, where **all** spectators must remain outside of the fence
  - If a player is injured & requires assistance the referee will ask the Coach or Team Manager to come onto the field to assist
- Mini Roos Age Groups
  - No coaches in any age group are permitted on the field
  - Coaches are not permitted to walk up & down the side-line; they to remain in one place with their team
  - If a player is injured the game leader will ask the Coach or Team Manager to come onto the field to assist

# > Interchange

- Mini Roos Age Groups
  - Can take place at any time during the match
  - The new player enters the field of play after the interchanged player leaves
- Under 12, Under 14 & Under 16 & Open Girls
  - Can only take place when the ball is out of play
  - Player & coach to move to centre line & waits for the referee to indicate that an interchange can take place
  - The new player enters the field of play after the interchanged player leaves

#### Referees & Game Leaders

- All Referees & Game Leaders are appointed by SJSA
- Any Coach or Team Manager who is unhappy with the performance of a Match Official must bring their concerns to the attention of their Delegates & the Delegate will submit the concern in writing to the SJSA Executive Committee via email.
- We encourage congratulations on a job well done be provided directly to the game leader / referee after the match & positive feedback to be submitted to SJSA Administration

# > Zero Abuse Tolerance

- Promote good sportsmanship
- Code of Conduct must be signed by all players, parents & coaches
- Includes behaviour in technical areas
- Responsibility for spectators associated with team/school/club
- Racial vilification will not be tolerated in any way
- Consequences for breeching zero abuse policy

# Ground Time

All players across all age groups are to have equal ground time; participation & player development cannot be achieved sitting on the bench watching team mates play!

#### > Child Safe

- Working with children checks are mandatory for all coaches & team managers; it is free (apart from the photo) for volunteers
- Copies of cards are to be forwarded to School / Club Delegate which will then be forwarded to SJSA Secretary

# Duty Day

- Schools / clubs will be rostered on to assist with set up or pack up each week
- The set up & pack up will be guided by the SJSA Executive
- Volunteers will also be rostered to assist with the Canteen, BBQ & other duties as required
